

ICD-10 CODES FOR MENTAL HEALTH CHEAT SHEET

Notes

- Most common ICD-10 codes for mental health start with the letter F.
- Less common conditions begin with G or Z.
- Most commonly billed mental health condition in the US is “generalised anxiety disorder” (F41.1).

The F Table of [Mental Health Disorders](#) Classification

F00-F09	Organic, including symptomatic, mental disorders
F10-F19	Mental and behavioural disorders due to psychoactive substance use
F20-F29	Schizophrenia, schizotypal and delusional disorders
F30-F39	Mood [affective] disorders
F40-F48	Neurotic, stress-related and somatoform disorders
F50-F59	Behavioural syndromes associated with physiological disturbances and physical factors
F60-F69	Disorders of adult personality and behaviour
F70-F79	Mental retardation
F80-F89	Disorders of psychological development
F90-F98	Behavioural and emotional disorders with onset usually occurring in childhood and adolescence
F99	Unspecified mental disorder
F00*	Dementia in Alzheimer disease
F02*	Dementia in other diseases classified elsewhere

These codes include disorders of psychological development, but excludes symptoms, signs, and abnormal clinical and laboratory findings not elsewhere classified.
